**Schedule of Classes**

## RULES

1. Entries for all classes must be in accordance with Daffodil Society rules.
2. The RHS Classification of Daffodils will be followed throughout the schedule. 'Divisions' are as defined in the RHS Classification of Daffodils.
3. All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor.
4. No exhibitor may stage more than one exhibit per class (except seedling classes 49 & 50).
5. Exhibitors may stage from 8.30am to 11am on the day of the show. The area will be cleared for judging at 11am.
6. Every exhibit must bear a card (obtainable from the Secretary). These cards must be placed with the exhibit.
7. All exhibits should be correctly named with the exception of new cultivars, which may be shown under numbers.
8. No artificial aids should be inserted or fixed to the stem to aid staging of exhibits.
9. Foliage is not required, but if used, it must be daffodil foliage.
10. The judge's decision is final and he/she is empowered to withhold awards if the exhibit is deemed unfit or not according to schedule.
11. Any complaint must be made in writing and will be considered by the committee.
12. The show is open to both members and non-members of The Daffodil Society Wessex Group, resident within the Wessex area. The Wessex area, for the purposes of this schedule, covers the traditional county boundaries of: Gloucestershire; Somerset; Dorset; Wiltshire; Hampshire; and W.Sussex.

## TROPHIES, POINTS, CERTIFICATES AND ROSETTES

**THE DAFFODIL SOCIETY GILT MEDAL and a Rosette**, will be awarded to the Winner of the Wessex Championship Class. (Class 1)

**THE DAFFODIL SOCIETY SILVERED MEDAL and a Rosette**, will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining Most Points in the Show. (1<sup>st</sup> = 5 pts; 2<sup>nd</sup> = 3 pts; 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1 pt).

**THE DAFFODIL SOCIETY BRONZE MEDAL and a Rosette**, will be awarded to the Best Exhibit in Classes 2-5.

**THE AMERICAN DAFFODIL SOCIETY RIBBON**, will be awarded to the Winner of class 53.

**A FRANK CALCRAFT MEMORIAL CERTIFICATE**, will be awarded to the winner of class 2

**An ALAN PURNELL MEMORIAL CERTIFICATE**, will be awarded to the winner of class 3

A Certificate and a Rosette will be awarded for the **Best Bloom in Show** and **Reserve Best Bloom**.

Rosettes will also be awarded for:

- Best Collection of Divisions 5-13 (from classes 2 or 4);
- Best Vase of 3 Blooms (from classes 3-5);
- Best Blooms from each of Divisions 1,2,3,4, 5-13;
- Best Miniature;
- Best Local Exhibit (From Classes A, B, or C)

7 Section Winner Certificates and Rosettes will be awarded to exhibitors in the Single Bloom Classes.

- A One daffodil, any colour or variety.
