Note to exhibitors and judges

A shorter list could have been produced if only sub-species (subsp.) had been included and not varieties (var.). However, if in a class calling for six distinct miniatures both varieties *nivalis* and *graellsii* of *bulbocodium* subsp. *bulbocodium* were shown judges would then be unsure whether, or not, the exhibit was to schedule. Species are very variable and varietal names have been given to specimens which can be found in the normal spread of flowers within a species or sub-species population. When two such varieties are shown within the same collection then the judge will take this into account as he/she would when assessing a collection of standard cultivars for range of division and colour combinations.

Note on nomenclature added June 2015. *Asterisked species (in bold) in Section B list.

Recent taxonomic investigations of several *Narcissus* species have led to new nomenclatural changes being published. Unfortunately for our Society's interests, these changes have affected several species which frequently appear on the Show Benches.

The changes have been brought about by DNA "fingerprinting" techniques which are the most fundamental way that relationships among species can be decided. Yet many growers will assert that they can readily distinguish some of the species 'lumped' together in this new nomenclatural change, by well-recognised morphological differences.

The society's Classification and Technical committee has therefore decided for the time being to leave it to exhibitors to use either the existing nomenclature already shown in the Section B list or they may adopt the new nomenclature indicated below, a previous note of which was made in the Society's Journal in March 2015.

The general acceptance of the new names will be kept under constant review and, if widely accepted by the next issue of Section B, will then be fully adopted.
